

Bucklebury Manor Requirements List – Michelle Yeo, 2024

Bucklebury Chintz Fabric Design

3122-44 Main Bird Print- Cream – $\frac{3}{4}$ yd, 70cm

3125-44 Moiré Trails, Cream – $\frac{5}{8}$ yd, 70cm

3125-77 Moiré Trails, Prussian Blue – Fat $\frac{1}{8}$,

3125-77 Geometric, Red – $\frac{1}{4}$ yd

Kits will be available but cost has not yet been determined. Check back for updates.

Rotary Cutting Equipment (**Editor note: a couple of cutting mats will be available to share.**)

Appliqué Thread to match fabrics. Wonderfil has a Michelle Yeo Designer box of Efina threads to match the Bucklebury Chintz fabric line

Depending on preferred Appliqué Technique – Glue or Cotton thread for basting motifs onto background fabric

Mechanical pencil including coloured leads depending on fabrics used (0.7mm 2B is best)

Scissors for cutting paper, fabric, & thread

Heavy non-iron interfacing - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd or preferred material for making appliqué templates

Appliqué Pins

Appliqué Needles

Light Box (**Editor note: a couple of light boxes will be available to share.**)

Sticky Tape

**If wanting to do Buttonhole Appliqué instead of Needle-turn Appliqué:

$\frac{3}{4}$ yd Fusible web

Quilting weight thread to match colours in main bird print – I use Aurifil Mako 28.

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
